PROSECCO & CHAMPAGNE

1. Tosti Prosecco

The nation's favourite sparkling wine, by a long chalk. Unlike Champagne it doesn't have that chalkiness of flavour, instead opting for peach, apricot and mandarin flavours alongside the traditional pear, apple and citrus notes. A fine, soft mousse and just a subtle hint of sweetness make this a great example of our favourite bubbles.

2. Laurent-Perrier La Cuvee Brut

Redolent with orchard and stone fruits. The palate is peachy and creamy with notes of white fruits and summer flowers.

3. Laurent-Perrier Cuvee Rose Brut NV

The original rosé Champagne. Redcurrants, strawberries and red plum mix with aromas of toast and warm herbs. The palate is rich yet elegant with raspberry jus, mint and morello cherries. The mousse is finely structured and adds a touch of honeyed texture.

4. Dom Perignon Cuvee

Perhaps the world's most famous wine, Dom Pérignon defies easy description. Complex and elegant notes of nuts, peaches, aromatic spices and toast all mingle with caramel, orchard fruits and savoury, bready notes. It's long, concentrated and exceptionally generous.

ROSE WINE

5. Desert Rose White Zinfandel / USA

Imagine biting into a strawberry tart that has just a drizzle of sweet cherry syrup and you've got this off dry wonder. Fresh, juicy and with a gentle sugar hit.

6. Casa De Rossa Pinot Grigio Blush / Italy, Veneto

A light and refreshing rosé, with fresh cranberry and raspberry notes on the nose. On the palate, this wine is crisp, coupling citrus flavours with a strawberry core.

7 La Vidaubanaise Comte de Provence Rosé / France, Provence

As dry and crunchy as a dry and crunchy thing. Herbaceous red fruits with a hint of salinity, grapefruit and pomegranate. The very style that Provence is known, and indeed popular, for producing.

RICH & LUSH

8. **The Citrus Tree Chardonnay** / Australia, South East

A refreshing and crisp Chardonnay packed with grapefruit, lime and melon flavours, all bound in a zesty citrus balance which cuts through to the finish.

9. **Not Your Grandma's Riesling (VE)** / Australia, Eden Valley

Apples and orange blossom wash the tongue while the nose is seduced by flowers, lemon and lime...heady South Australian Riesling.

10. **Ladies Who Shoot Their Lunch**

Wild Ferment Chardonnay / Australia, Victoria

Vibrant and electrifying Chardonnay that doesn't play by the rules. Lemon curd, salinity, lime zest and notes of pastry and toast. A core of acidity keeps this fresh and moreish.

11. **Domaine Ferret Pouilly Fuissé** / France, Burgundy

Fuissé makes great Burgundy in its own right. Here is a core of lemon, peach and orange surrounded by fine mineral notes, lime zest, red apple and supple smokey vanilla.

CRISP & DELICATE

12. **Sartori Pinot Grigio Delle Venzie (VE)** / Italy - Veneto

Straw in colour with light golden hues, it has a fruity bouquet and a subtle, fresh flavour.

13. **Roquemolière**

Picpoul de Pinet Réserve / France, Languedoc

Soft, floral white from southern France, dry and delicate, exuding acacia, hawthorn blossom and citronella.

14. **Ramon Bilbao Albarino** / Spain, Rias Baixas

Albariño from a prestigious region of Galicia, tropical on the nose, with pineapple and passion fruit balanced by flowers and a juicy mouthful of apricot and mango.

ELEGANT & AROMATIC

15. **Mack & Collie Sauvignon Blanc** / New Zealand, Marlborough

Fresh herbs sprinkled over passion fruit and melon while lime zest hangs around in the background. This is bright, vibrant and full of energy and demands a second glass.

16. **d'Arenberg The Hermit**

Crab Viognier/Marsanne / Australia, McLaren Vale

Powerfully aromatic white, blasting out candied ginger and flowers, with notes of green mango, hay and almond on the palate.

17. **Gravestone Sauvignon/Semillon** / New Zealand, Waiheke

Herbaceous Sauvignon-Sémillon blend from northern New Zealand, the wild ferment bringing out notes of fennel bulb and tropical fruit as well as adding layers of texture.

RED WINE

SOFT AND SMOOTH

18. Vinamar Merlot / Chile, Casablanca Valley

Chilean Merlot, lightly spicy and packed with dark fruit, particularly blackberries and plums.

19. Trapiche Estacion 1883 Cabernet Franc / Argentina, Mendoza

A combination of dark strawberry and cherry fruit mingles with brambles and currants. Medium bodied with a refreshing acidity and melt in the mouth tannins. Luscious red and black currant notes.

20. Josph Drouhin Nuits St George

1er Cru Damodes / France, Burgundy

Powerful, elegant Burgundy, fragrant with cedar and juicy with cherries and blackberries, with a hint of sweet spice on the finish.

BIG & BOLD

21. Trapiche Melodias Malbec / Argentina, Mendoza

Flavours of black cherry, currants, plums and violets are all supported on a medium weight palate with super smooth tannins and a subtle refreshing acidity.

22. Trapiche Perfiles Malbec Textura Fina / Argentina, Mendoza

This Malbec is smooth, fruity and delicious with medium tannins and a fantastic structure.

23. Il Poggione Brunello di Montalcino / Italy, Tuscany

Rosso is the lighter, less aged wine from the clone of Sangiovese known as Brunello and this is lovely: concentrated and elegant,

with black cherry, blackcurrant and soft-serve vanilla on the nose, with coffee and black fruit in the mouth.

24. Chateau Durfort-Vivens Margaux / France, Bordeaux

A classic Margaux perfume rides over the top of blackburrant, blackberry and fine smokey cedar flavours. There is a fleshiness in the fruit but the structure is taut and elegant. Fine vanilla, dark cherry and plum and a note of minerality all lead this elegant and complex palate.

SPICY & EARTHY

25. Ramon Bilbao Monte Llano Tinto Rioja / Spain, Rioja

Red violet colour, with purple hues. On the nose the wine leaves subtle aromas of ripe fruits (blackcurrants, raspberries).

On the palate it is fresh, structured and very fruity.

26. Are You Game? Shiraz / Australia, Victoria

Plum-filled Shiraz from Victoria, south-east Australia, that fills the nostrils with cinnamon, black pepper and spice.

27. Bogle Vineyards Phantom / USA, California

A plush red blend from California that blasts out spice, juniper and toasted coconut, then fills the mouth with plums and blackberries.

Subtle, smooth & delicately smoky with a heathery honey finish.

Talisker 10 Year Old (45.8%)

Seaweedy & smoky with a peppery element.

Oban 14 Year Old (43%)

Burnt heather becoming smoky with a sweet malty characteristic

Dalmore 12 Year Old (40%)

Orange marmalade & spice on the nose with a malty sweet flavour.

Dalmore 15 Year Old (40%)

Honey & sherry notes complement the distinctive orange character of the Dalmore. Smooth & velvety on the palate with hints of bitter chocolate on the finish.

Dalmore 18 Year Old (43%)

Finished in Matusalem sherry casks. Hints of pine & spicy cinnamon on the nose with a faint suggestion of orange marmalade. Chocolate, vanilla & Parma violets on the palate & a warm, pleasing finish.
